

- Research Participants:
- 15 female sex workers
- 1 ex-sex worker
- 3 male sex workers
- 3 'middle men'
- 1 client
- 1 ex-boyfriend of a sex worker

Sex work in Luganville

"Because life is hard. In order to buy a shell of kava, or food for the house – they can't afford it. The next option, if they don't have a job, the next option is you must sell yourself. That's it. You must make a bit of money out of your body so that you can afford what you want."

A sample of dialogue...

Me: But do they [clients] know where they can get condoms?

Jeremy: Yes, but they're not interested in condoms.

Tim: For safety they must use them...

Jeremy: But from what I see - no.

Tim: Vanuatu style – skin-to-skin.

[Laughter]

Me: But do people know about the risks?

Tim: Everyone knows about the risks, but they don't want to use the modern technology which are condoms. They're all grasshoppers or what! [Laughs] But Score, no, they don't want them.

Jeremy: One other things is they are fast – f*** quickly, then leave. They forget.

Findings continued...

- Sex work and SRHR in Luganville:
- Condom use, or non-use
- STI, HIV/AIDS, treatment seeking behaviour
- Family Planning, and pregnancy
- Sexuality
- Risks and human rights abuses, example of 'Anne' (FSW, 37 years)
